## **Policy on Undergraduate Unit Load Limitation**

**Applicability:** All CSU Channel Islands undergraduate students

**Purpose:** To establish unit load limitations for undergraduate students

**Background:** SP 03-04 establishes unit load limitations for undergraduate students and provides a means for exceeding such limitations. This revised policy maintains existing policy for students in good academic standing while creating a lower unit load limitation for students on academic probation. It also includes a procedure that students on academic probation may pursue to exceed the new limitation.

## **Policy:**

- 1. An undergraduate student in good academic standing may enroll in up to 18 units without advisor approval.
- 2. An undergraduate student on academic probation may enroll in up to 13 units without advisor approval.
- 3. Undergraduate students in good academic standing who wish to enroll in more than 18 units are required to have
  - a. written approval from the chair or a faculty advisor in the student's declared major, as specified by the major program, or
  - b. written approval from an academic advisor if the student has not yet declared a major.
- 4. Undergraduate students on academic probation who wish to enroll in more than 13 units are required to have an academic advisor's written approval.
